time to insure that the boys have a great opportunity to learn Scouting and embrace its values.

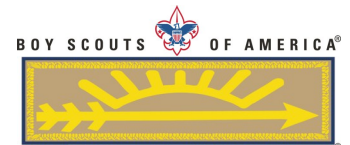
